
# Continuing momentum – Financial trends for Q3 FY23











# Key developments

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

# Rainbow Children's hospital performs rare procedure to save a preterm baby



- The Vijayawada Hospital, is the first hospital in the state of Andhra Pradesh to perform a complex surgery to place a permanent pacemaker in a 2.5-month-old baby
- A 29 weeks pre-term newborn baby with extreme low birth weight of 900 gm was identified to have complete Heart Block in prenatal echo
- On 2nd day after birth baby had temporary pacing wire surgery followed by permanent pacemaker insertion at 2 ½ months of age. Baby is now doing well

# Successful surgical management of a child with continuous urinary leak



- A 7-year girl from Uganda presented with continuous urinary dribbling since birth. She was operated for the same in Uganda, but the problem persisted
- She was evaluated at Rainbow by our Pediatric Urologists who did a thorough endoscopic and radiological evaluation and to their surprise, they identified three kidney units for the girl
- The girl was operated upon by our team who made appropriate reconnections of the draining tubes from the 3 kidneys and the dribbling stopped
- The child recovered completely and for the first time in her life, she was off diapers. She has now returned to Uganda and attending school normally

# Exit Procedures – Guindy, Chennai



- Chennai's hub hospital performed first EXIT procedure (ex utero intrapartum treatment procedure). It is a specialized surgical delivery procedure to deliver babies who have airway compression
- In this procedure the baby needs to be operated at the time of delivery before clamping of umbilical cord
- This procedure is extremely complex and requires a team of doctors including Obstetrician, Fetal Medicine, ENT surgeon, Neonatologist and Anaesthetist

# Madhukar Rainbow Children's Hospital, New Delhi- performs a rare procedure to save a child with congenital medical problem

- **Madhukar Hospital, Delhi performed a complex and rare operation to remove (Bronchogenic cyst) in the chest of a two months old baby**
- **The baby came to the hospital with difficulty in breathing, bluish discoloration of hands and feet and oxygen level was very low**
- **CT scan confirmed that a cystic lesion (Bronchogenic cyst) in the chest was causing compression in the windpipe leading to severe breathing problem. ## Fibroid Weighing 2 Kg Successfully Removed With Help Of Surgery

A 24 year old woman who was soon to be a bride was feeling uneasy for the last six months. When the doctors did a blood check-up, they found out that she was severely anemic. Doctors found that she was detected to have a large fibroid (almost 8-months pregnant uterus size on an average). Her uterus was of the size

of a watermelon due to the fibroids. Dr. Shwetha .S. Kamath (Obstetrician, Gynaecologist and Laparoscopic Surgeon at Rainbow Hospital, Hebbal) said, "The fibroid could be removed laparoscopically through small incision. A key hole surgery would ensure that her recovery was faster, less blood loss, less hospital stay, less chance of infec-



tion or hernia and more cosmetic. She was able to get married on the pre-fixed date with all vigour, happiness and was stress free.

## 2kg fibroid removed from woman's uterus

A 24-year-old Bengaluru woman underwent a successful surgery to remove a 2kg fibroid in her uterus, almost the size of a watermelon, at a private hospital in the city.

For the past six months, the woman had been experiencing symptoms like tiredness, breathlessness, bloated stomach, heavy periods etc. However, she ignored all symptoms due to her ongoing wedding preparations.

One day, she fainted and was immediately admitted to a hospital. She was found out

to be severely anaemic, with a low haemoglobin level of 3 (normal level is 11). In further evaluations, she was detected to have a large fibroid, making her uterus the size of an nearly eight-month pregnant woman.




Dr. Shwetha S Kamath, obstetrician, gynaecologist and a laparoscopic surgeon said they performed a successful surgery and discharged the woman

within two days. The fibroid was removed laparoscopically through a small incision which will ensure faster recovery. The woman was also able to get married on her pre-fixed date completely stress free, the doctor added.
