# Rainbow Children's Medicare Limited Announces Q1 FY26 Results; Strengthens Regional Presence with Warangal<sup>1</sup> Acquisition

- Expanded into Warangal through acquisition, strengthening Tier 2 presence
- Revenue grew 7% YoY, backed by strong performance from newer facilities
- EBITDA up by 11%, PAT up by 35%, driven by operational efficiency and cost discipline
- New hospitals on track in Rajahmundry, Bengaluru, Coimbatore, and NCR

**Hyderabad, July 26, 2025**: Rainbow Children's Medicare Ltd (RCML), a leading pediatric and perinatal healthcare provider in India, is pleased to share its operational highlights and strategic developments for the quarter ended June 30, 2025.

In a key strategic milestone this quarter, the company entered Warangal - Telangana's second-largest district - through the acquisition of a majority stake in Prashanthi<sup>2</sup> Hospital. This marks a significant step in RCML's plan to strengthen its footprint in underserved tier-2 cities, further supporting the company's hub-and-spoke model to ensure high-quality, specialized care reaches a broader catchment area across the state.

Operationally, Q1FY26 reflected steady momentum across the network, with revenue growing 7% year-on-year, supported by the strong performance of newer units and consistent demand for high end services such as tertiary and quaternary care. EBITDA increased by 11% and PAT by 35%, highlighting continued operating leverage and disciplined cost management. Growth during the quarter was achieved despite seasonal trends that typically affect the early part of the fiscal year, underscoring the resilience of RCML's model and the successful integration of its expanding network.

RCML continues to assess inorganic and greenfield/brownfiled opportunities for its future expansion. The company is confident in the fundamentals of its business and the growing demand for specialized pediatric and perinatal care across India and remains focused on bridging this gap with proven clinical expertise, future ready and supportive healthcare infrastructure, deep market penetration and a concerted focus on building a paradigm of care.

# **Key Developments**

- Update on Projects:
  - The regional hub hospital in Rajahmundry (~100 beds) is almost ready and awaiting requisite approvals to commence operations
  - Construction at the spoke hospitals in Electronic City (~90 beds) and Hennur (~60 beds), Bengaluru, is progressing well, with both facilities expected to be operational by the end of Q2 FY26.
  - o At Coimbatore, the development of our 130-bed regional hub is progressingly well.
  - o In the National Capital Region, project activity is well underway at both Sector 44 (~325 beds) and Sector 56 (~125 beds) in Gurugram, with excavation work actively progressing at both locations.
- Rainbow Children's Hospital continues to maintain a robust balance sheet with cash, cash equivalents, fixed deposits, and mutual fund investments totaling Rs. 7,355 Mn as of June 30, 2025. These funds will support our ongoing capital expenditure plans. With our current cash and anticipated internal accruals in coming quarters, we are well-positioned to complete all planned capital expenditures using internal resources.
- During the quarter, the company invested Rs. 415 Mn in capital expenditures towards expanding and enhancing our services at existing hospitals.

Welcoming Prashanthi Hospital, Warangal, into our network stands as a significant step as we extend our reach into promising Tier 2 regions.

Looking ahead, our key priorities include advancing clinical capabilities, reinforcing operational excellence, and ensuring the on-schedule launch of our new hospitals. We remain confident that the strength of our care model, the expertise of our teams, and our disciplined execution together will allow us to deliver accessible, high-quality healthcare for mothers and children across geographies."

The doctors work in teams and have 24/7 commitment, which is particularly important for children's emergency, neonatal, pediatric intensive care services and to support pediatric retrieval services. The Company also operates the country's largest pediatric DNB training programme in private healthcare, offering post graduate residential DNB and fellowship programme.
